



Clovelly SLSC – Information for Patrolling Members

To commence Patrol at Clovelly for the 2018/19 season all members need to be Financial – submitted an online renewal form and paid – if you are not sure please email registrar@clovellysurfclub.com.au **Proficient** – you can check your proficiency status for all your Award /s in your Members Area account, <https://members.sls.com.au> Once logged in click Memberships > Awards.

When Am I Rostered to Patrol?

You can view your roster in your Members Area account, <https://members.sls.com.au> If you login to your account on your mobile device you can download the roster to the calendar on your phone. Once logged in click Patrols > Patrol Roster. The patrol roster can be downloaded from the website Clovelly website <http://clovellysurfclub.com.au/lifesaving/patrol-teams-roster>

What Patrol Team Am I On?

Patrol Substitutions/Swaps

The club uses the substitution/swap function in the Members Area for members to request and accept subs. All subs/swaps requested via the Members Area can be viewed by the Lifesaving Team, this enables us to plan and act if we know there are patrols in the future that are going to be short, especially Christmas – New Year, January holidays and Easter. ***Get in early – check the sub/swaps section in the Members Area now – this way you can help someone out who needs a sub in the first few weeks and be ahead of the game when you need a sub*** 📧

Need a Patrol Sub? Browse to <https://members.sls.com.au> and login. Select Patrols > Patrol Roster, find the patrol you need a Sub for and click “I need a substitute” If your substitute request is not accepted by another patrolling member you need to let your Patrol Captain know as soon as possible.

Need to Make Up a Patrol?

If you miss a patrol or arrange a substitute for a patrol you need to make the patrol up. Browse to <https://members.sls.com.au> and login. Select Patrols > Patrol Swap, find a patrol that you are able to do and click “I can do this” .

Annual Skills Maintenance:

Members must complete their Skills Maintenance before the 31st of December of each year. This is a refresher of your CPR, Rescue techniques and a Run-Swim-Run in 8 minutes. Members who do not complete their skills maintenance by 31st of December, are not permitted to patrol and must make special arraignments with the Director of Education to apply for a late skills maintenance. This season Skills Maintenance is a combination of eLearning modules accessed via the Members Area and practical demonstration. Who do I contact if I have any questions about your patrol team, roster or subs?

Your key point of contact is your Patrol Captain (PC).



Patrol Requirements for Specific Membership Categories

Active 18yrs and Over

Must complete all rostered patrols. If you cannot attend a patrol, please let your Patrol Captain know and then login to the Members Area to request a substitute. If you cannot get a substitute you let your patrol captain know at least 3 days before your rostered patrol.

Active 15-18yrs

Must complete all rostered patrols, however, we appreciate that you may have compulsory school commitments (both academia and co-curricular). If you cannot attend a patrol, please let your Patrol Captain know and then log into the Members Area to request a substitute <https://members.sls.com.au>. If you cannot get a substitute you need to let your patrol captain know at least 3 days before you rostered patrol

Cadet (SRC)

Cadet members have been allocated to a patrol team, however, there is flexibility to this arrangement. Cadets can patrol on their allocated team, **and/or** attend any other patrol **and/or** do Nippers Water Safety on a Sunday morning. If a Cadet member signs on to a rostered patrol, we ask that you stay for a minimum of 2 hours if possible. Cadet members assisting with Nipper Water Safety on a Sunday morning must make themselves known to the Nipper Water Safety Co-Ordinator and sign on to the water safety log. If you don't sign on your hours will not be logged.

Patrol Hours requirements for Cadet Members (SRC Award Holders only) for the 2018/19 season are as follows: -

1. Must complete **10 hours** (rostered patrols or nipper water safety **by 31 December 2018**
AND
2. Must complete **10 hours** (rostered patrols or nipper water safety by **28 April 2019**).

Active Reserve

After completing 10years of active service, members transition to Active Reserve and are required to complete 16 hours of patrols during the season. We encourage Active Reserve Members to login to the Members Area on a regular basis and accept sub requests. This assists those active members who need a sub and helps to ensure the patrols have adequate strength.
