SAFEGUARDING OUR CLUB

The more people who are aware of the signs of abuse and what to do if they notice them, the more Surf Life Saving Australia and our club can provide an environment which protects children and young people.

Surf Life Saving have developed a free online learning course which takes approximately 20 minutes to complete. It provides practical examples and scenario-based training which aims to increase members' awareness of child abuse and child protection, and to improve their confidence to be able to take appropriate action when they become concerned for the safety of a child. We encourage all members to consider completing the course to indicate that Clovelly supports Surf Life Saving Australia's initiative.

There is also a new set of guidelines which complement this training, providing written information about abuse, indicators of abuse and how to report. These guidelines also include information from the SLS Codes of Conduct. When accessed and completed via the [SLSA Members Area](#), members' records will automatically be updated with the SLS Safeguarding Children and Young People Awareness award.
