**TRAINING & PROFICIENCY THIS SEASON:** Clovelly SLSC is using a new format for Skills Maintenance with a combination of Online Theory and practical skills sessions at Clovelly. This will help:

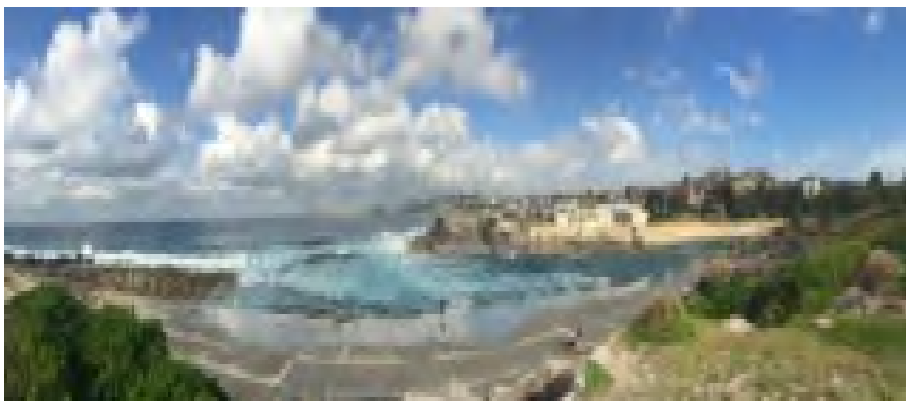
- \* Reduce the amount of face-to-face time required at the club doing skills maintenance.
- \* Free up trainers involved in training BM, SRC & IRB Driver squads and conducting Nipper education sessions.
- \* Ensure all members are maintaining the standard of knowledge and expertise required of Surf Lifesavers

You must complete **online theory** components **prior** to attending a practical assessment, accessible via your [Members Area account](#) Click the **'eLearning'** tab, and then login to eLearning. You will be forwarded to the eLearning system. Click the **'My Training'** tab, find the **"SLS – Skills Maintenance 2019/20"** tile, and click **'View.'** The eLearning this year includes brief Resuscitation & Tourniquet updates.

**\*\*There is also a Mandatory module for Patrol Captains/Silver Beach Management: Click the 'Training Library/SLS New South Wales/SLSNSW-Supplementary Learning for Patrol Captains/Enrol/Process Payment'** [the training is free].

1. **Patrols Start Date** – Patrols commence on Saturday, **28<sup>th</sup> September 2019**.
2. **Patrol Teams** – Patrol teams have been finalized & are on the Clovelly SLSC website [Click Here](#).
3. **Patrol Roster** – The Patrol roster has been uploaded to the Clovelly SLSC website [Click Here](#). You can also view and download your roster via your [Members Area](#) account.
4. **Can't Make Your Patrol & Need a Swap?** – Get in early – check the Swaps section in your Members Area. If you need a sub, requests can be made via your Members Area account. Once you have logged into your account, in the 'Patrols' tab dropdown select 'Patrol Swap'. If your swap does not get accepted (you will be notified 72 hours prior to the patrol if it hasn't) you need to let your Patrol Captain know. *(When lodging a sub request, please accept a sub for someone else- this way all subs will get covered)*
